5 Education/Training report

In the last 12 months IRRV East have arranged and successfully delivered 3 quality training courses across Revs and Bens. In

comparison to previous years, it's been reasonably busy for education. Thankfully we have had a very high level of take-up.

In preparing these courses, I have been careful to research and choose the right training provider and thankfully they haven't disappointed.

Oct 2015 – Introduction to Business Rates

Delivered by Dave Marsden at AVARTO Bertelsmann

The course was charged out at £100 per delegated, which was extremely good value for Local Authorities.

The course was well attended, with 14 delegates across East Anglia (ARP, Ipswich, Broadland & Nth Norfolk).

The feedback was rated as 4.5 (out of 1-5) with no specific learning issues raised.

Dec 2015 – HB Claimants from Overseas

Delivered by Andy Thurman at HBInfo

A slightly more expensive course, so we charged places at £150.00 still very good value for Local Authorities.

The course was originally limited to 15 places, however due to demand I squeezed in another 2 places. Delegates attended from ARP, Kings Lynn, Nth Norfolk, Gt Yarmouth & Cambridge so covered 11 Local Authority's across East Anglia.

Only 6 delegates provided feedback, which was in the main 4-5/5 with only a couple of '3's' for venue facilities (the room was very full)

May 2016 - HB Self Employed

Delivered by Peter De La Mothe at HBInfo

The course was charged out at £150.00 per delegate and was limited to 15 places.

Due to a last minute plea for a place, we sold 16 places with delegates attending from ARP, Cambridge, Broadland and South Norfolk.

Peter was very well received and delivered a comprehensive and quite entertaining course.

The feedback was again very good, with comments such as 'interesting', 'lots of examples' & 'well presented', there were no negative comments. Most of the delegates asked that we arrange a Company Directors course which I plan to arrange in the coming months.

I am also keen to ensure we meet the training needs within all Revs & Bens Depts across the East, so if anyone has any requests for courses, please do email me and I will make some enquiries.
